Have fun with the projects and prepare them well and get the analysis done as soon as possible to avoid to many projects at once.



The workload is heavily concentrated to the last part of the course making it hard to take other courses in parallel. Some more co-planning with e.g. the Planet & Starformation course would be good.


Though this is averaged over the entire course duration. The time spent was highly concentrated in the last 4-5 weeks at a rate of approximately 45 hours a week.

It was not an even workload. In the beginning it was much less than towards the end after all the data were taken.




