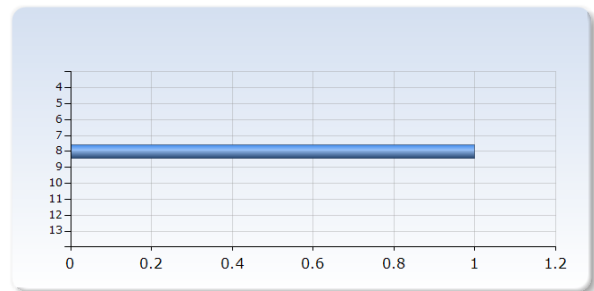

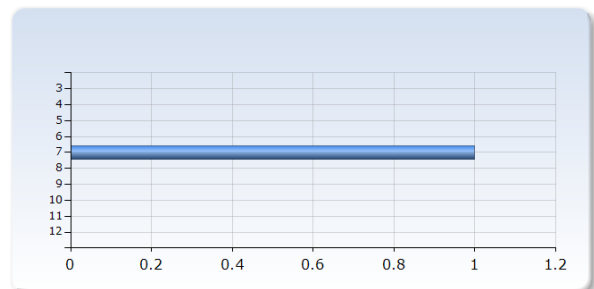

## . Description of changes since the previous time the course was given.

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## . What are the course's strong points according to the students (summary based on the numerical results as well as their free text answers)

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A decent fraction said they were likely to use what they had learned during the course, and that the examination(s) were well-aligned with the learning objectives. The majority said they could understand what was being taught, and that the learning outcome was positive. Prerequisites were appropriate. they liked the real-time feedback from lecture to lecture.

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## . What are the course's weak points according to the students (summary based on the numerical results as well as their free text answers)

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It's a bit difficult to tease out from the numbers, but the most general negative point was possibly a lack of clarity regarding the expectations.

There was a negative reaction to the exercises, being too long, and for which there was one deadline at the end.

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## . The teacher's analysis of the course

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For the first time I have given the course it was generally positive. The first half was better prepared than the last, and I agree that the exercises could have been intense.

There is also a lot of material in the course, and it may be prudent to remove some parts of it, in favour of gaining a more thorough appreciation for others.

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## . Conclusions as well as suggestions for improvements

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Next time:

- possibly reduce the course content and focus on some areas.
  - divide the exercises into field-specific problems and request submission along with the course program (instead of all at the end)
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
